

ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN NOTICE

TO: Parents, Students, Faculty and Staff:

Federal regulations require that schools be inspected for the presence of asbestos, a toxic material that has been used in the construction industry for a number of years. This school has been inspected for asbestos containing materials and the results of the inspections are contained in the Asbestos Management Plan. This plan has been sent to the State authority in charge of Asbestos Abatement.

The Asbestos Management Plan includes the results of all the inspections conducted on all the school buildings. It also contains the results of the material samples which were taken during the inspections and the plans for asbestos abatement.

The Asbestos Management Plan is available for review during regular working hours at the LaFargeville Central School. A copy of the Asbestos Management Plan will be made, on request, for a nominal fee to cover the cost of copying and handling.

Recent scientific and medical evidence has shown that asbestos containing materials can be harmful to the human body. The Asbestos Management Plan shows the amount of asbestos present in this school building, as well as the specific locations of the asbestos. The LaFargeville Central School continues to maintain the standard of safety that is expected of this institution.
