

We are very excited to announce the numbers in Jefferson County have dropped significantly and the metrics have been met within our District so we are beginning extracurricular activities. We are currently putting plans together for music, theater, clubs, and other activities that will be announced at a later date via the District website and Facebook page. At this time, we are beginning winter sports (basketball and cheerleading) assuming we have interested students under the following conditions:

**General Information:**

- Students can only participate if they attend all classes that day (in-person on in-person days and virtually on remote days)
- Students must meet all academic and behavioral expectations as defined in the Student Code of Conduct
- Masks must be worn at all times including in practice and during competition in order to participate
- Social distancing must be adhered to whenever possible
- Disinfecting and handwashing must occur as much as possible
- Students should bring their own water bottle and come dressed for practice as practicable
- Parent signature and completed health documentation is required for participation
- Temperature checks will be taken by all participants (adult and student) prior to each activity (including practice) and prior to getting on a school bus (should any participant temp 100 or higher the participant will immediately be sent home and the activity may be cancelled until a negative test result is received)
- All extracurricular activities will be cancelled if the District is forced to remote learning
- Should Jefferson County's 14-day rolling average of positive results grow to be 4% or over according to [forward.ny.gov](http://forward.ny.gov) all activities may be cancelled
- Must follow all Department of Health and Public Health regulations

**Spectators/Attendees/Streaming:**

- There are no spectators or guests allowed in the building during practices
- Schools in Jefferson County are currently only allowing home spectators at all games
- By NYS mandate only 2 persons per participant are allowed and all entering must have their temperature taken and must fill out a COVID questionnaire before entering
- Spectators must be masked at all times and must sit socially distanced from anyone who does not live in your immediate household

**Athletics Schedule:**

- Varsity level interscholastic competition only for winter and fall sports. Spring sports may include all levels.
- Intramural sport activities may be developed for fall and spring seasons if modified sports aren't happening
- Anticipated Season Dates for LaFargeville CSD Athletics\*\*\*\*:
  - Winter: March 10 – March 31 (Games begin on or after March 17)
  - Fall II: March 22 – May 1 (Games are anticipated to begin the week of April 12 weather permitting)
  - Spring: April 19 – June 18 (Games are anticipated to begin the week of May 3)

\*\*\*\*Students playing in multiple seasons will finish their current season prior to beginning the next season (pitchers and catchers excluded)
