Legal Notice of Annual Meeting and Election

Notice is hereby given that the public hearing of the inhabitants of LaFargeville Central School District, qualified to vote at school meetings, in said District, will be held at LaFargeville Central School on Monday, May 12, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. E.S.T., for the transaction of such business as is authorized by the Education Law. Among the issues to be discussed are: The proposed 2025-26 school budget and the proposed election of a School board member for a five (5) year term. The Public Hearing will be adjourned until Tuesday, May 20, 2025, at which time (from 1:00-8:00 p.m.) voting will take place on the following items listed below:

1. 2025-26 school budget;
2. Election of a school board member to succeed Matthew Duffany for a term of five years;
3. Any other proposition which might have been brought before the voters previously.

Notice is given that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes, exclusive of public moneys, may be obtained by any taxpayer in the District during the fourteen days immediately preceding the Budget Vote except Saturday, Sunday, or holidays, at the LaFargeville Central School between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. or by contacting Nicole Parliament, Business Manager at 315-658-2241 or nparliament@lafargevillecsd.org. The tax exemption report is also available for the public to review.

Notice is further given that petitions nominating candidates for the office of Member of the Board of Education must be filed with the Clerk of the District or Business Office at least 30 days before the election, no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 21, 2025. Candidates for election are required to submit 3 expenditure statements to the School District Clerk. The first statement must be submitted no later than 30 days before the election. A second statement must be submitted no later than five days before the election. The third statement must be submitted within 20 days after the election. Forms for the above petition and expenditure statements may be obtained by any voter from the Clerk of the District.

The following vacancy is to be filled on the Board of Education, and will be voted upon Tuesday, May 20, 2025: Term: 5 years Last Incumbent: Matthew Duffany

Each vacancy is a separate specific office and a separate petition is required to nominate a candidate to such separate office. Each petition must be directed to the Clerk of the District, must be signed by 25 qualified voters of the District, must state the name and residence of the candidate and must describe the specific vacancy for which the candidate is nominated, including the length of term of office and name of the last incumbent.

Notice is further given that the applications for early mail and absentee ballots for election of school board members and adoption of the annual budget may be applied for at the office of the Clerk of the District at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter; that a list of all persons to whom absentee ballots and early mail ballots shall have been issued will be available in the said office of the Clerk on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of election, during regular business hours, except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

Notice is further given that military voters who are qualified voters of the School District may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application from the District Clerk at 315-658-2241 or mpapin@lafargevillecsd.org. For a military voter to be issued a military ballot, the District Clerk must have received a valid ballot application no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 25, 2025. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail.

CARTHAGE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

CONTRACT FOR HEALTH AND WELFARE SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT made in duplicate this 10th day of February, 2025, by and between Lafargeville Central School Board of Education of Jefferson County of LaFargeville, New York 13656, party of the first part, and Carthage Central School District Board of Education of Jefferson County of Carthage, NY, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that whereas the party of the first part has been duly empowered by the provisions of Section 912 of the Education Law to enter into a contract for the purpose of providing health and welfare services for children residing in said school district and attending non-public schools in the Carthage Central School District, Carthage, NY, County of Jefferson to begin on September 3, 2024 and end on June 30, 2025.

NOW, therefore, the said party of the first part hereby agrees to pay the party of the second part the sum of \$1,072.78 for health and welfare services to be provided under Section 912 to approximately 2 children residing in said District, and attending non-public schools in said Carthage Central School District.

AND, the party of the second part hereby agrees with the party of the first part as follows:

1. The health and welfare services provided under section 912 shall consist of the following:
 - Physician services
 - Nursing services
 - School Psychological Services
 - School Speech Correctionist Services

.....such services may include, but are not limited to all services performed by a physician, dentist, dental hygienist, nurse school psychologist, school social worker or school speech correctionist, and may also include dental prophylaxis, vision and hearing test, the taking of medical histories and the administration of health screening tests, and maintenance of cumulative health records and the administration of emergency care programs for ill or injured pupils.

2. The party of the second part will also furnish the following equipment to be used in providing such services if requested by the authorities of the non-public school:
 - Supplies and equipment for use by physician, school nurse-teacher, psychologist, dental hygienist, social worker, and speech correctionist (i.e. scales, vision and hearing testing devices, health record forms, first aid supplies, and all other readily transportable equipment and supplies pertaining to delivery of services)

It is expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that the services agreed to be supplied under this contract shall not include any teaching service.

It is mutually agreed that this contract shall not become valid and binding upon either party thereto until the same shall be approved by the superintendent of schools.
